Heart and Vascular Care, Inc. (“Heart and Vascular Care”, “we”, “our”, “us”) knows you care about your privacy and the protection of your personal *information* and we are committed to providing the necessary protection to your online privacy.

This Privacy Policy (“Privacy Policy”) describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit hvcmd.com and any other website that links to this Privacy Policy (the “Site”) and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information. Please read on to learn about our collection and use of your personal information and how we protect your privacy. By using or accessing the Site in any manner, you acknowledge and agree that you accept the practices and policies outlined in this Privacy Policy, and you agree that we may collect, use and share your personal information as described herein.

Information Collection

We may collect the following kinds of information when you use the Site:

Information You Provide To Us. We collect information you provide directly to us through the Site. For example, we collect information when you use or register for the Site, subscribe to notifications, register for an event, make a donation, apply for a job, or transact or otherwise communicate with us through the Site. This information may include personal information such as contact information (e.g., your first and last name, email address, home address, telephone number or date of birth), job application information, and billing information (e.g., payment card details). We may combine such information with information we already have about you.

Information We Collect Automatically. Heart and Vascular Care may automatically collect certain information when you access or use the Site. This information may include location information, IP address, device identifier, browser type, domain name, operating system, information about your use of the Site, internet service provider, pages that you visit before and after using the Site, the date and time of your visit, information about the links you click and pages you view within the Site, and other standard server log information. We may use various tools such as cookies, web beacons and other online tracking technologies to collect this information. We may

combine certain *automatically-collected* information with other information we obtain about you, which may include information we obtain from third parties.

In addition to logging information about your visit, we may use various tracking mechanisms such as cookies, web beacons (also known as tracking pixels), and embedded scripts (collectively, "Tracking Technologies") to automatically collect information about interactions with our Site or e-mails.

1. Cookies are small data files that a web browser places on your computer. The use of cookies is a common practice on many websites. We may place cookies on your computer to allow us to recognize you on the Site during future visits, to measure web traffic, to offer you certain products or services, or to customize your visit. Your Internet browser may include settings that permit you to block cookies or to be notified when cookies are placed.
2. Web Beacons (also called "tracking pixels") are small graphic images, also known as "Internet tags" or "clear gifs" that are embedded in web pages and e-mail messages. Web beacons may be used for various purposes, such as to count the number of visitors to the Site, to monitor how users navigate the Site, or to verify how many articles or links were actually viewed.
3. Embedded Scripts are designed to collect information about your interactions with the Site. These scripts are temporarily downloaded onto your computer from our web server, or the server of a third party with whom we work.

In some instances, a browser may include settings that allow you to preemptively block cookies from being placed on your computer.
